

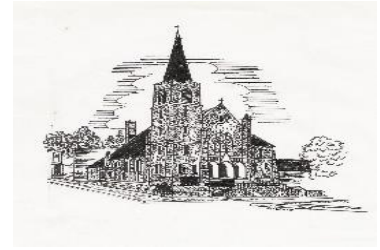

SAINT OF THE WEEK / Saint Thomas Aquinas

By universal consent, Thomas Aquinas is the preeminent spokesman of the Catholic tradition of reason and of divine revelation. He is one of the great teachers of the medieval Catholic Church, honored with the titles Doctor of the Church and Angelic Doctor. His greatest contribution to the Catholic Church is his writings: their unity, harmony, and continuity of faith and reason. The *Summa Theologiae*, his last and, unfortunately, uncompleted work, deals with the whole of Catholic theology. He died in 1274. He is the patron saint of Catholic universities, and philosophers / theologians. His feast day, January 28, always precedes the celebration of Catholic Schools Week.
