

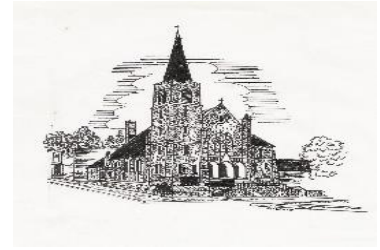

SAINT OF THE WEEK / Saint Hilary, Bishop and Doctor of the Church

He was bishop of Poitiers in France. This staunch defender of the divinity of Christ was a gentle and courteous man, devoted to writing some of the greatest theology on the Trinity, and was like his Divine Master in being labeled a “disturber of the peace.” His holiness was lived out in both scholarship and controversy. As a bishop, he battled against the heresy confronting the fourth century, Arianism, which denied the divinity of Christ. Hilary refused to sign a condemnation of Athanasius, the great defender of the faith in the East, and was banished to Phrygia (present day Turkey). While there, he wrote and debated against a heretical bishop who sent Hilary back to France. Hilary was known for his great courage of faith in the face of punishment and exile. His feast day is January 13.
