

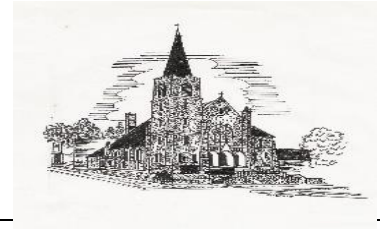

SAINT OF THE WEEK *Saint John the Baptist*

We celebrate three birthdays in the Church Year: Jesus, Mary the Blessed Mother, and John the Baptist. Everything we know about John's birth is contained in the first chapter of Saint Luke. His father Zechariah became mute because he didn't believe the angel's pronouncement that Elizabeth would bear a son. When Mary visited Elizabeth during her pregnancy, Luke tells us that John "leapt in her womb" at the arrival of Mary, pregnant with Jesus. When John was born, his family members thought he should be named Zechariah. However, Zechariah wrote on the tablet, "His name is John," and Zechariah regained his speaking voice. John the Baptist prepared the way of the Lord. Although John was a "precursor" for the start of Jesus' public ministry, we are "post-cursors" who proclaim the Risen Lord to all. The feast day of the Birth of Saint John the Baptist is June 24.
