

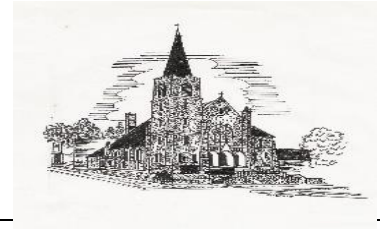

**SAINT OF THE WEEK** *Saint Irenaeus, Bishop, Martyr, Doctor of the Church*

The Church is fortunate that Irenaeus was involved in many of its controversies in the second century. He was a well-trained student with great patience in investigating, tremendously protective of apostolic teaching, but prompted more by a desire to win over his opponents than to prove them in error.

As bishop of Lyons, he was especially concerned with teachers ("Gnostics") who erroneously claimed access to secret knowledge imparted by Jesus to only a few disciples. Their teaching was attracting but confusing many Christians. Through his writings and teachings, he gradually ended their influence. His feast day is June 28.
