

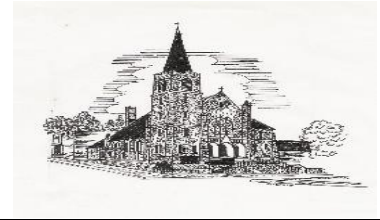

The congregation of the Missionaries of St. Francis de Sales was founded in Annecy, France in 1837. They are now globally present in 29 countries with more than 1500 priests. They work among the poor, disadvantaged, marginalized and illiterate children's homes, orphanages and schools. More than 3500 children are cared for and educated. They also care for retired priests who have absolutely no income and depend on the congregation for support in their old age.
