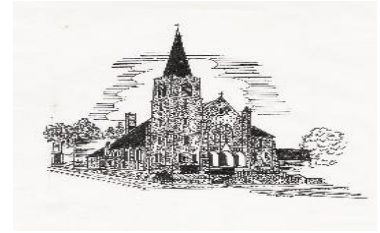

SAINT OF THE WEEK *Saint Boniface, Bishop and Martyr*

- Born 675, died 754
- Monk known as “The Apostle of the Germans”
- Devoted his life to the conversion of Germanic tribes to the Christian Faith
- His two chief characteristics: his Christian orthodoxy and his fidelity to the Church
- Not only converted pagans to Christianity, but reformed the lax clergy
- Established many Benedictine monasteries
- He and his companions were martyred while preparing converts for Confirmation
- He bore the Christian rule: to follow Christ is to follow the way of the cross
- His feast day is June 5
