

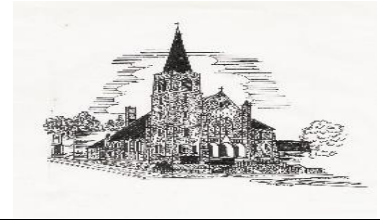

SAINT OF THE WEEK *Saint Mary Magdalene*

Except for the mother of Jesus, few women are more honored in the Bible than Mary Magdalene. Mary Magdalene was the one from whom Christ cast out "seven demons" (Luke 8:2)—an indication at the worst, of extreme demonic possession or possibly, severe illness. Mary Magdalene was one of the many "who were assisting Jesus and the Twelve out of their means." She was one of those who stood by the cross of Jesus with his mother. And, of all the "official" witnesses who might have been chosen for the first awareness of the Resurrection, she was the one to whom that privilege was given. She is known as the "Apostle to the Apostles." Mary Magdalene is the patron saint of penitents and perfumers. Her feast day is July 22.
