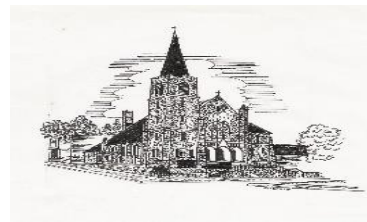

SAINT OF THE WEEK *Saint Kateri Tekakwitha, Virgin*

When she was four, Tekakwitha lost her parents and little brother in a smallpox epidemic that left her disfigured and half blind. Through the teaching of Jesuit missionaries, she became a Catholic at age 19. Her family treated her like a slave. Since she did not work on Sundays, they did not feed her that day. Nevertheless, she was powerfully moved by God's love and saw the dignity in each member of her tribe, even if they treated her horribly. She escaped to a Christian native American community near Montreal. Kateri dedicated her life as a virgin to Jesus Christ through prayer, in charity, and in strenuous fasting and penance. After she died on the day before Holy Thursday in 1680 at age 24, her emaciated face changed color and became like that of a healthy child. The lines of suffering, even the pockmarks, disappeared and the touch of a smile came upon her. Kateri was canonized in 2012 and her feast day is July 14. She is the patron saint of indigenous peoples.

COURAGE APOSTOLATE is a ministry for Catholics with same-sex attraction who are striving to live faithfully to the teachings of Christ and His Catholic Church. Courage meets monthly in Morgantown for prayer, fellowship, and support. The heart of Courage is the belief that sanctity is possible in everyday life. Through the Courage Apostolate those persons experiencing same-sex attractions are encouraged to deepen their Christian discipleship through participation in the sacramental life of the Church, particularly through the frequent reception of the Eucharist and frequent confession, as well as through a regular prayer life, witness, counsel, service, and self-giving.
