EUCHARISTIC MIRACLE THIS WEEK TERESA NEUMANN (Germany 1898-1962) Teresa Neumann's life changed radically after her miraculous recovery from being paralyzed and totally blind at the age of 25. About a year after she was cured, she received the stigmata (the wounds of Christ at the Crucifixion). At this time, she began fasting, with the Eucharist as her only food. Every Friday she would be drenched in blood, experiencing the Passion of Christ and His crucifixion. Hitler was very fearful of Teresa. During World War II the Nazis withdrew her food rationing card and gave her a double rationing of soap to wash her bloody towels and clothing. For the last 36 years of her life, her only nourishment was the Holy Eucharist. Her priest and bishop studied and examined the life of Teresa and confirmed: "The significance of Teresa Neumann's fasting is to show the people of the world the value of the Holy Eucharist, to make the world understand that Christ is actually present in the bread of the Eucharist and that through the Holy Eucharist, physical life can actually be preserved."
