



LENT 2024

Lent is a special season within the Church year that focuses on the two-fold theme of **repentance** and **Baptism**. Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, February 14, 2024, and ends at Holy Thursday Mass, March 28, 2024. Our Mass schedule for Ash Wednesday is **8:30 AM and 12:00 PM at Sacred Heart, and 6:30 PM at Immaculate Conception**. Please check with other parishes if our times are not suitable.

Lenten Pillars: ***Fasting, Prayer, Almsgiving***

IMPORTANT GUIDELINES FOR ALL CATHOLICS

Fasting is to be observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by everyone 18 years and older, who has not yet celebrated their 59th birthday.

One full meal is allowed.

Two other meals, enough to maintain strength, may be taken, according to each one’s needs, but together they should not equal another full meal.

Eating between meals is not permitted, but consuming liquids, including milk and juices, is allowed.

Abstinence is observed by everyone 14 years of age or older.

On days of abstinence, no meat is allowed.

When health or the ability to work is affected, the law does not apply.

Days of abstinence: Ash Wednesday, all the Fridays during Lent, and Good Friday.

If a person is unable to observe the above regulations due to ill health or other serious reasons, other suitable forms of self-denial are encouraged.

Anointing of the Sick on Sunday, February 25

Eucharistic Adoration every Thursday during Lent, beginning at 9:00 AM and ending with Mass at 6:00 PM. There are sign-up sheets at each church door. Those who sign up will come every Thursday during Lent beginning Thursday, February 15 through Thursday, March 21. If you are unable to come at your designated time, please call the parish office so that we can find a replacement. You can also come anytime up until 6:00 PM without signing up.

Stations of the Cross
